Aggarwal College is an eminent college of district Faridabad and rendering marvelous humanitarian activities through its dedicated Youth Red Cross unit, during lockdown period they have taken following initiatives to provide help to the poor and needy people of the community :-

1. Aggarwal College is having 150 YRC Volunteers (92 Girls + 58 boys) who participated in various awareness activities.
2. 485 YRC youths (292 Girls + 193 boys) are trained in First Aid, Home Nursing, Personal Hygiene & Sanitation, Epidemic Control and take special training for COVID-19 to meet any type of emergent situation.
3. 400 Packets of Dry Ration at their own level and 500 packets of dry ration having cost of Rs. 80,000/- through District Red Cross Branch, Faridabad have been distributed by the Youth Volunteers and benefitted 900 persons during the lockdown. The services are still continued.
4. 1500 packets of cooked food have been distributed during this period.
5. Cloth Face Mask, sanitizer, hand gloves, soaps and hand wash have been distributed to the general public free of cost. IEC material, E-banners, slogans etc have been made for general awareness about COVID-19.
6. Through Social Networking and direct awareness of YRC Volunteers around 2800 persons in urban as well as in rural areas have been aware about social distancing, personal hygiene and do's & don't for prevention against COVID-19.
7. Various online competitions i.e. Quiz competition, slogan writing, poster making, poem writing, video making, best out of waste etc. have been organised so that more and more volunteers would join in awareness campaign.

List of Activities

- 1. Household survey:** Our unit started the process of village adopted by the college in month of Jan - Feb, 2020. Four villages were surveyed already in Jan- march 2020, the fifth village 'Sahupura' was surveyed in month of October 2020. The UBA campaign was started in the form of household survey of the adopted villages with the help of UBA volunteers of Aggarwal College Ballabgarh. At least 250 houses were surveyed in each village. The study was conducted using standardized Baseline Household Survey forms developed by UBA to assess the living conditions of the villagers. The data of survey of some of the villages has been uploaded on the UBA Portal and for rest of the villages the process is going on.
- 2. Village Survey:** After the household survey, a meeting with village Sarpanch and members of village Panchyat was organized in March, 2020 in order to gather all the details regarding roads, transports available, Land, forest and horticulture profile, village infrastructure and basic amenities. In this meeting, major problems traced during the household survey were discussed among villagers and their list was prepared.
- 3. Online COVID – 19 awareness campaign:** An online awareness campaign (from April 2020 to August 2020) in villages adopted was done by UBA coordinators through village headman (Sarpanch) and a whatsapp groups was formed. Members of these groups were Sarpanch, Panch and other dignified people of the concerned village along with faculty members from college. All the instructions from Ministry of Health, Central and State governments was shared from time to time and village headman was asked to distribute the information to other villagers as well. Information regarding COVIDVEER, AROGYASETU APP, Extension of lockdown period, Guidelines from MHA, GOI, Useful Information from WHO and guidelines about closure of school/college/universities were also sent.
- 4. Awareness program on National Education Policy (NEP):**

(a) Meeting with the Villagers: Various meetings in the adopted villages were organized by the members and volunteers of UBA cell to spread the awareness about the NEP from 17.09.2020 to 22.09.2020

(b) Poster Making Competition: An online poster making competition on NEP was also organized on 20.09.2020

(c) Webinar on NEP_UBA

- Three webinars were conducted to spread and aware the public at large including the students, faculty and the common people in the adopted villages on 22nd&23rd Sept, 2020
- Two UBA Volunteer, Preeti Saini & Sapna took the role of speakers and presented their PPTs on NEP.
- More than 500 people participated in the webinars and other activities related to the spread of NEP.

5. Information about new technologies developed in research labs: A number of techniques that has been developed by CSIR research laboratories keeping in view the climatic conditions all over India were shared with villagers in the adopted villages. On 24/09/2020, the college UBA team met the Sarpanch and other village persons about these technologies. Some of the villagers showed keen interest in these new techniques and agreed that utilizing new techniques and their experience would not only improve their agricultural product but also increase employment and resources.

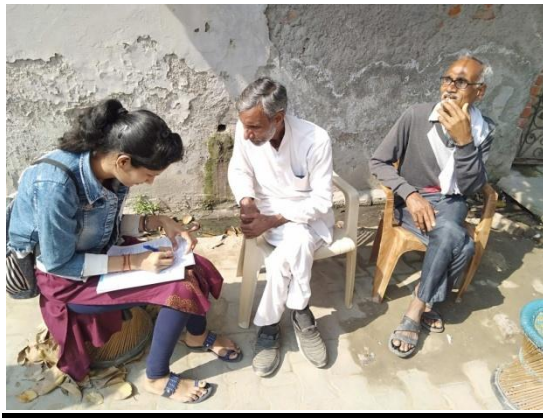

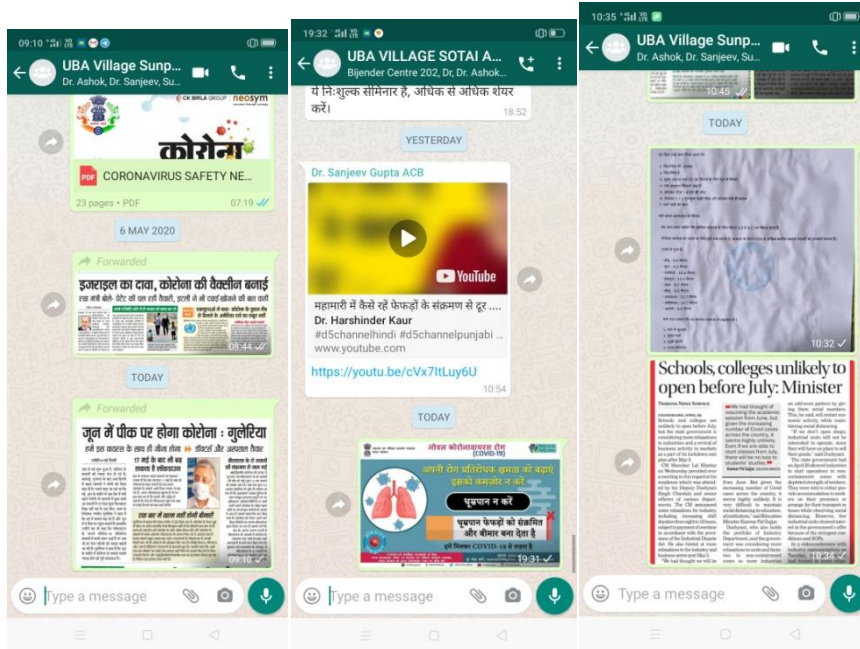
