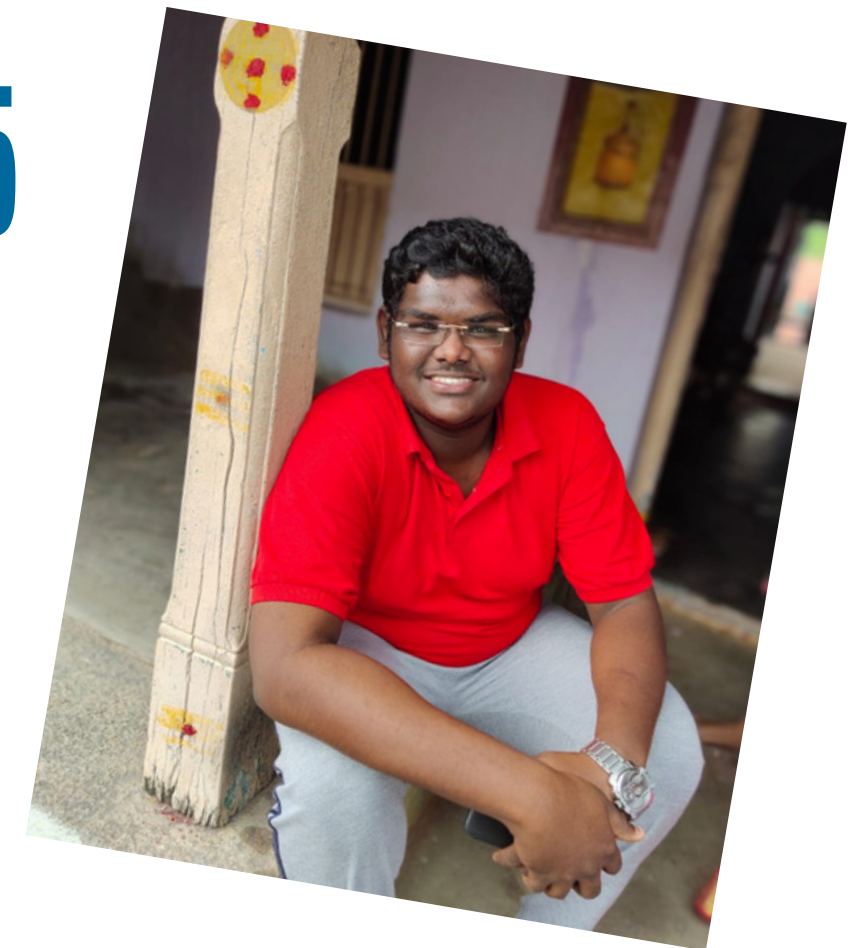
Ensure Healthy lives and promote well being for all at all ages. Health for all people, at all over the world, is an important part of sustainable development.

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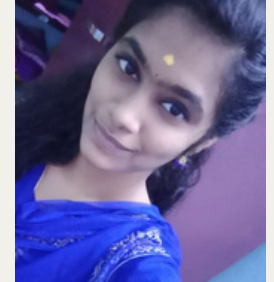
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
