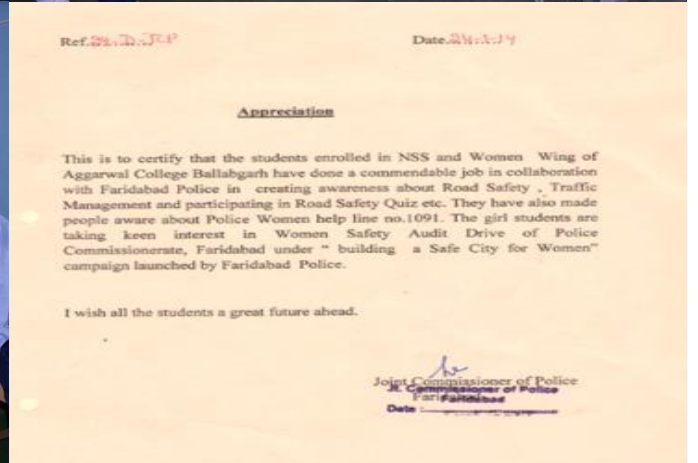


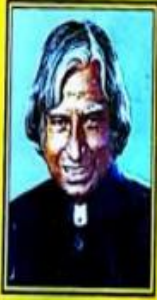

Our Red cross volunteers rendered their services to District Administration Faridabad in distributing cooked food for approximately 1000 persons daily for one and half months during lock down period.

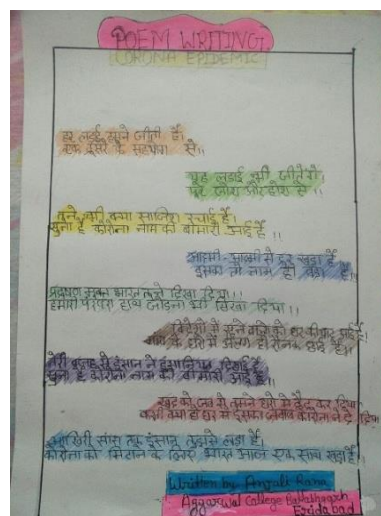
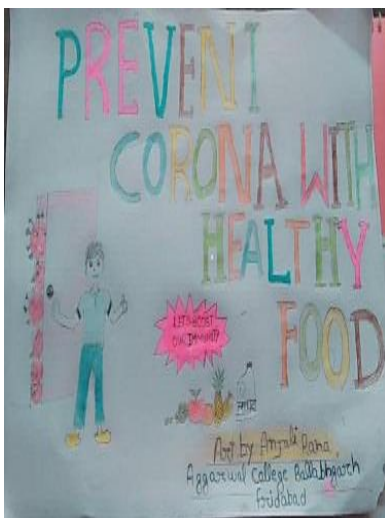
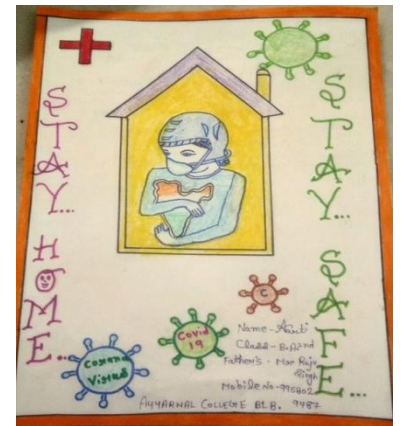
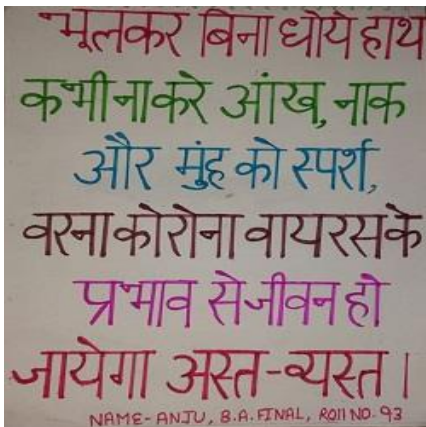
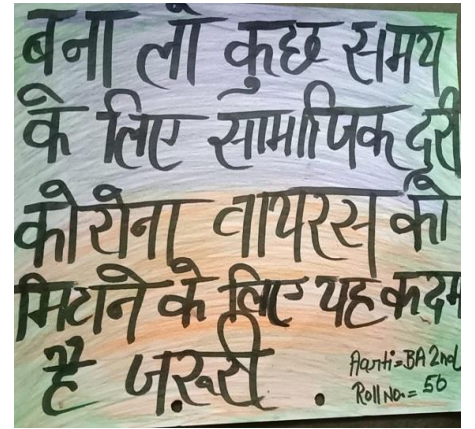
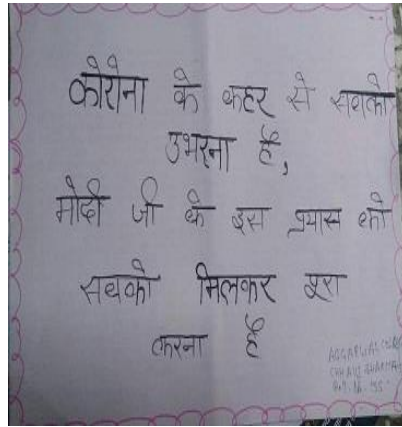


2. Distribution of Dry Ration & Food Packets by Aggarwal College Ballabgarh under the leadership of Dr, Krishan Kant

Aggarwal College is an eminent college of district Faridabad and rendering marvelous humanitarian activities through its dedicated Youth Red Cross unit, during lockdown period they have taken following initiatives to provide help to the poor and needy people of the community:-

1. Aggarwal College is having 150 YRC Volunteers (92 Girls + 58 boys) who participated in various awareness activities.

3. 400 Packets of Dry Rations at their own level and 500 packets of dry ration having cost of Rs. 30,000/- through District Red Cross Branch, Faridabad have been distributed by the Youth Volunteers and benefited 900 persons during the lockdown. The services are still continued.
4. 1500 packets of cooked food have been distributed during this period.
5. Cloth Face Mask, sanitizer, hand gloves, soaps and hand wash have been distributed to the general public free of cost. IEC material, E-banners, slogans etc have been made for general awareness about COVID-19.

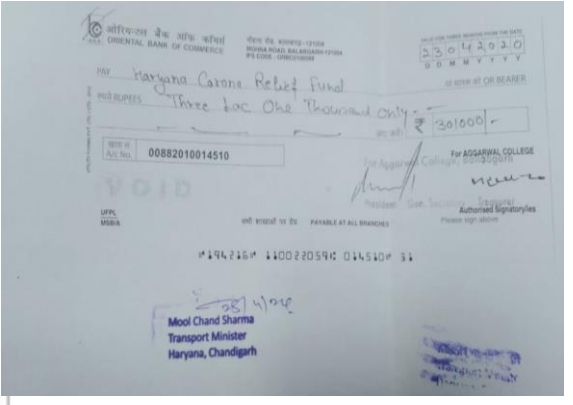
